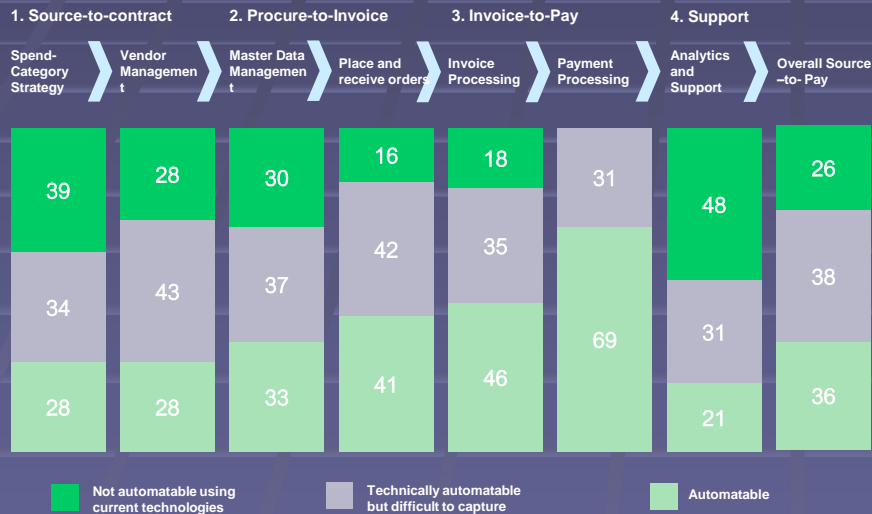

# The Case of Public Procurement

## Automation: A way to solve the procurement bottleneck?

Automation could dramatically reduce time spent on transactional procurement

### Percent of total employee activity within example process stages
