

#### A new policy context


- Policy priorities of the Commission, 6 headline ambitions:

  - EU research, innovation and technological development for security as key enabler






#### A more impactful Security R&I investment

#### **iProcureNet**

**Procurement agencies** or departments, active at budgeting and implementing the acquisition of security solutions at European, national, regional or local level get together to: 1) **share** investment plans, 2) **compare** procurement techniques and rules, and 3) **plan** for common procurements of **research services as well as of innovative, off-the-shelf products**.

- Knowledge at the service of public buyers and policy-makers to foster the uptake of innovation by contributing to the:
  - Political buy-in and the willingness to change public procurement cultures;
  - Understanding of where existing procurement spend goes vs. what are the future needs;
  - Proliferation of innovation-friendly public procurement strategies or approaches in the field of civil security;
  - Actionable evidence on the feasibility and relevance of those strategies, notably when these are implemented jointly by several EU authorities;
  - Alignment of EU-funded R&I programming and results with real and tangible procurement opportunities in the field of security
