



ENCIRCLE Concept







PROCUREMENT RECOMMENDATIONS



THE PURPOSE:

One of the aims of the i-LEAD project is to identify the joint procurement recommendations and areas for Law Enforcement Agencies, which can later serve as the basis for the preparation of joint technical specifications.

OPEN SOURCE INTELLIGENCE:

Ideas for joint procurement of:

- Tool/software that would allow more automotive data input, sharing and analysis;
- Software allowing linking data from various tools used by LEA;
- Tool allowing geo-location and supporting geo-spatial standards.



EXPECTED SOLUTIONS:

- Software that would allow automatic data input and assignments search;
- Improvement of system interoperability;
- Joint training and exchange of information/good practices between OSINT practitioners and investigators;
- Real-time intelligence monitoring.



STANDARDISATION AND PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Unification of data formats and data sharing procedures;
- Standard information reporting schemes and standard EU report formats;
- Structured OSINT competence framework and training curricula;
- Procurement of:
 - Tool/software that would allow more automotive data input, sharing and analysis;
 - Software allowing linking data from various tools used by LEA;
 - Tool allowing geo-location and supporting geo-spatial standards.


i-LEAD is funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020 - Research and Innovation Framework Programme, under grant agreement no 741661.

KEY FINDINGS:

1. It is **constantly needed to organize dedicated training for LEA**, focused on Innovation Partnership – how to implement it in practice;
2. It is needed to **raise the awareness about PCP, PPI and Innovation Partnership initiatives**, highlighting that risk is natural element of Procuring of innovation solutions and it should be accepted, especially by decision makers.




